Bring your lifetime of experience and values of faith into volunteering. Some of the projects looking for volunteers are:

- CooperRiis – A healing farm in Mill Spring, North Carolina
- Westside Food Bank – Surprise, Arizona

The program for Older Adults offers some different options from the regular BVS process including:

- **Come check us out:** Older Adults are invited to attend the older adult orientation which is held each Spring, to explore volunteering without making a commitment to serve.
- **Term of Service:** If you choose to commit to serve, older adult volunteers are required to serve a minimum of six months with the option of extending their term of service. The start date for project is negotiable depending on the needs of the volunteer and the project.
