A gift of \$150 assists L'Eglise des Freres, the Church of the Brethren in Haiti, in "harvesting" water resources on La Tortue island. Though surrounded by water, the islanders lack access to potable water over the dry months. The gift aids construction of a 5,000-gallon cistern and cementing of an existing retention pond near a school and preaching point of the Haitian church.

A gift of \$100 underwrites a loan for a Lenca Indian family in Honduras to purchase small livestock. The borrowers, long entrenched in poverty, reside in the buffer zone of Cerro Azul Meambar National Park, a critical watershed area. Led by Project Global Village, the enterprise works with the Lencas on three fronts: land renewal, food security, and economic opportunity.

A gift of \$75 helps train youth in southern Sudan to generate income from agriculture—youth who have had little opportunity for schooling. The gift provides handtools, vegetable seeds, and mango and guava seedlings to two Bible schools of the African Inland Church. The schools integrate gardening with religious training and equip young people to return home to farm.

A gift of \$50 purchases a bag of high quality rice seed for the Ryongyon farm rehabilitation program in North Korea. Working in the land of stark hunger with partner agency Agglobe, the Global Food Crisis Fund helps four large cooperative farms revitalize agricultural production. The Brethren engagement in North Korea is further extended by placement of a faculty couple at Pyongyang's brand new University of Science and Technology.
