Brethren Disaster Ministries helps get relief to victims of natural disasters. We will be collecting clean up bucket supplies and money as an offering during worship. Then as a way of serving, we will be organizing the materials and stuffing the buckets. This is the list of items to bring to donate: Four scouring pads; Seven sponges, including one large; one scrub brush; eighteen reusable cleaning towels (e.g. Easy Wipes); one package of 48-50 clothespins; clothesline, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.; five dust masks; two pairs non-surgical, non-latex gloves; one pair work gloves, cotton with leather palm or all leather; 24-28 heavy duty or contractor type 30-45 gallon trash bags on a roll and removed from carton; one 6-9 oz. bottle of non-aerosol insect repellent. BDM will supply the buckets, cleaning soap and laundry detergent. This list is also online at brethren.org/nyc.
