2. Report of the Leadership Team

The Leadership Team provides guidance and leadership for the denomination and executive leadership for Annual Conference committees. It is composed of the Annual Conference officers (Moderator, Moderator-elect, and Secretary), the General Secretary, a district executive representing the Council of District Executives, and the Director of Annual Conference serving as ex officio.

The Leadership Team serves as the executive committee for Annual Conference; provides general oversight of Annual Conference in consultation with the Annual Conference Program and Arrangements Committee and the Conference Director; delegates tasks from Annual Conference actions; interprets Annual Conference decisions and denominational polity; and reviews recommended changes in Annual Conference guidelines and policies.

Through in-person meetings, video conferences, and email exchanges throughout 2023, the Leadership Team responded to correspondence from individuals and congregations expressing a variety of concerns, considered a funding request for the Standing with People of Color committee, and discussed the need for a draft mandate for the upcoming Review and Evaluation process. The Team also reviewed business items coming to Standing Committee and Annual Conference in 2024, including queries coming from districts, and when requested, provided support to the Standing Committee subcommittees developing agency covenants and a process for addressing concerns with agencies.

The Team considered updates to the *Manual of Organization and Polity*, including the need for an updated translation into Spanish and translation into Haitian Creole. A decision regarding the distribution of funds received through a Church of the Brethren partnership with Brotherhood Mutual benefitted districts, undergirded the Annual Conference budget, and will provide support for a future Leadership Summit with the Leadership Team and the Council of District Executives.

The Team acknowledged lament and grief over the departure of 143 congregations that have been officially reported since 2019 and the loss of the churches of Puerto Rico District. Continued outreach to the Puerto Rican church leadership is ongoing in an effort to better understand the contexts that have resulted in our disparate perceptions of their withdrawal so that we can be better informed and equipped to walk alongside and help heal divi-sions within the Body of Christ moving forward with careful listening and mutual respect. An additional concern was the future sustainability of Annual Conference, which the Team will continue to address in 2024 while also find-ing ways to keep the denominational vision front and center in congregations and districts.
