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4 The Pastoral Compensation and Benefits Advisory Committee ("PC&BAC") 5 seeks to serve the denomination by providing support for pastors and congre-6 gations in establishing fair levels of compensation and benefits for pastors and 7 by developing tools and resources for use by congregations. PC&BAC has devel-8 oped the Integrated Annual Ministry Agreement, which includes the Annual 9 Shared Ministry Priorities Agreement as tools. One of our prayers is that these 10 tools will help pastors and congregations to create clarity around how they work 11 together. For more information, please visit the Ministry Office section of the 12 Church of the Brethren website: https://www.brethren.org/ministryoffice/ The 13 committee includes representation from laity, a secular compensation profes-14 sional, a pastor, and a district executive. In addition, the committee works closely 15 with the Office of Ministry and the Council of District Executives (CODE). 16

Since last year's Annual Conference, the committee:

- 18 • Participated in a joint meeting of the Northern Indiana and South-Central 19 Districts for in-depth discussions regarding the Integrated Annual Ministry 20 Agreement, the Annual Shared Ministries Agreement, and use of the Com-21 pensation Calculator 22 • Initiated a review and revision of the Church of the Brethren Guidelines for
- 23 Sabbath Rest, which began with evaluation of information received in re-24 sponse to a survey on this topic. 25
- Continued to work with Eder Financial on refinements to the Compensation 26 Calculator and revisions to the Housing Equity Fund. This year's business 27 item NB3. Housing Fund Recommendations is the result of the committee's 28 partnership with Eder Financial and the Mission and Ministry Board. 29
- Continued to work closely with CODE to coordinate our work.
