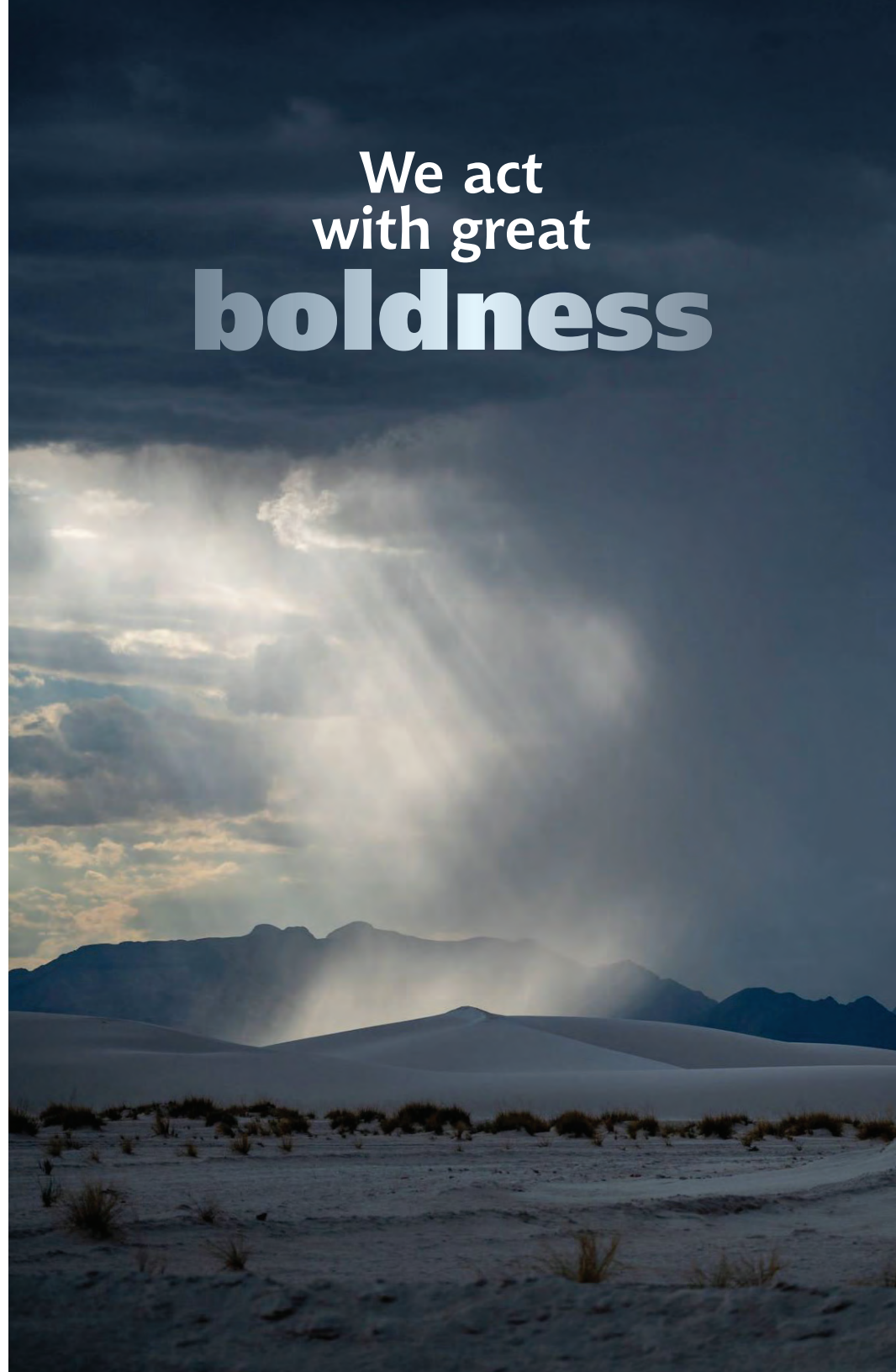


We act with great **boldness**
