Worship: Confession of Jesus as Lord

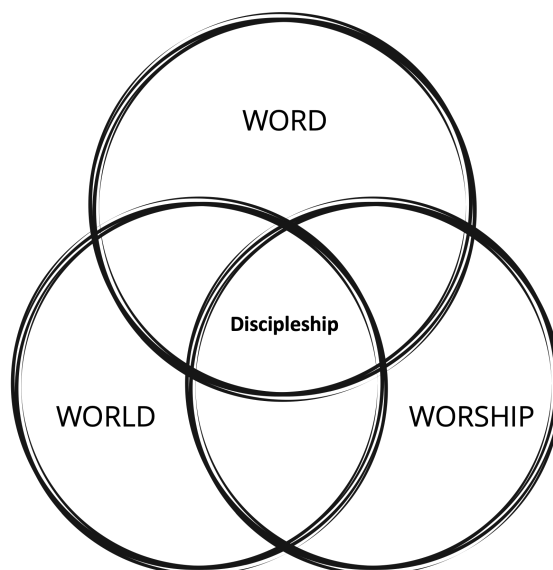
World: Entering into a community of faith
