Definition of Discipleship

Discipleship is the intentional journey of becoming like Jesus through practices at the intersection of Word, Worship, and World that forms new selves, new social relationships, and a new social imaginary.

Dominant Culture

We are formed into Races, Classes, Genders, and Abilities.

I Corinthians 5:17 (CEB)

So then, if anyone is in Christ, that person is part of the new creation. The old things have gone away, and look, new things have arrived!

Discipleship Culture

Transforms us into Siblings in Christ, Neighbors, and bearers of the Image of God.

Social Imaginary

A social imaginary is a mental framework that makes it possible to live in the world with others and not have to think about every movement or action.

Our Operating System

Like a computer's operating system our social imaginary helps us connect our embodied experience and intuitively act in the world.
