

# The Church in 1 Corinthians: Challenges for Today

June 29 & 30, 2021

Dr. Gorman is a New Testament scholar who specializes in the letters, theology, and spirituality of the apostle Paul. His additional specialties are the book of Revelation, theological and missional interpretation of Scripture, the gospel of John, and early Christian ethics. In addition, he has a strong interest in the relationship between church and culture.

Dr. Gorman is the author of nearly twenty books and more than sixty articles on Biblical interpretation and on ethics. Among his books are several on Paul: *Cruciformity: Paul's Narrative Spirituality of the Cross* (2001); *Apostle of the Crucified Lord: A Theological Introduction to Paul and His Letters* (2004; 2nd edition, 2017); *Reading Paul* (2008); *Inhabiting the Cruciform God: Kenosis, Justification, and Theosis in Paul's Narrative Soteriology* (2009); *Becoming the Gospel: Paul, Participation, and Mission* (2015); and *Participating in Christ: Explorations in Paul's Theology and Spirituality* (2019). He is also working on a brief commentary on Romans.

Dr. Gorman was the 2005 recipient of The Fortress Press Award for Innovative Teaching in Graduate Schools and Seminaries, theological education's "teacher of the year" award. A United Methodist, Dr. Gorman is an active layperson and a popular teacher at colleges, seminaries, churches, and conferences representing many traditions.

In addition to traditional academic study and teaching, Dr. Gorman is an avid traveler and has led several study trips to Greece/Turkey/Rome and to France/Switzerland. He has also traveled to Israel/Palestine and taught in Cameroon.
