The Global Mission office supports emerging and ongoing missions and projects around the world. It also is a founding member of the Global Church of the Brethren Communion, a fellowship of national bodies of the Church of the Brethren that was founded in December 2019 at a four-day conference held in Nigeria. After several years of meeting virtually every few months, and supporting one another through mutual encouragement, sharing resources, and supporting each other's efforts, the communion formally organized in 2023.

The communion numbers 12 national bodies of the church in these countries, listed in alphabetical order: Brazil, Democratic Republic of Congo, Dominican Republic, Haiti, Honduras, India, Nigeria, Rwanda, Spain, Uganda, United States, and Venezuela.
