- Team Ministry** – two or more ministers serving the same congregation.
- Yoked Parish** – a minister serving more than one congregation—the congregations maintain separate programs and identities.
- Tenure** – the total number of years or months the minister served the congregation in this position as of December 31, 2019.
- Seminary** – the minister is a graduate of Bethany Theological Seminary or other seminary. **Please indicate name of other seminary.**
- TRIM** – the minister is certified through the Training in Ministry program.
- ACTS** – the minister is certified through the Academy Certified Training Systems program.
- EFSM** – the minister is certified through the Education for Shared Ministry program.
