2 - Wait, but aren't there still enemies out there?

3 - Still in hot pursuit?

4 - Pursuing me all day long?

2,3,4 - Oh no!

1 - You're right, the enemies don't magically disappear. Just remember when we're afraid we can get through the fear because we put our trust in God.
